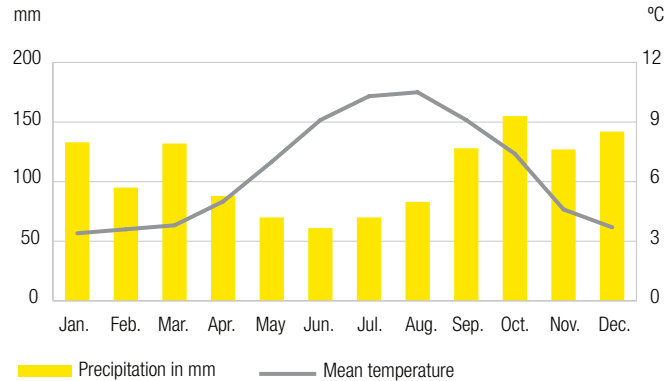

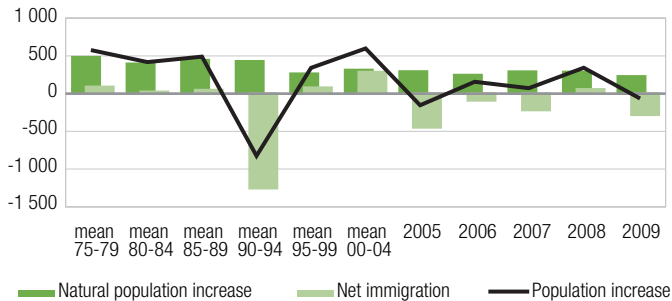

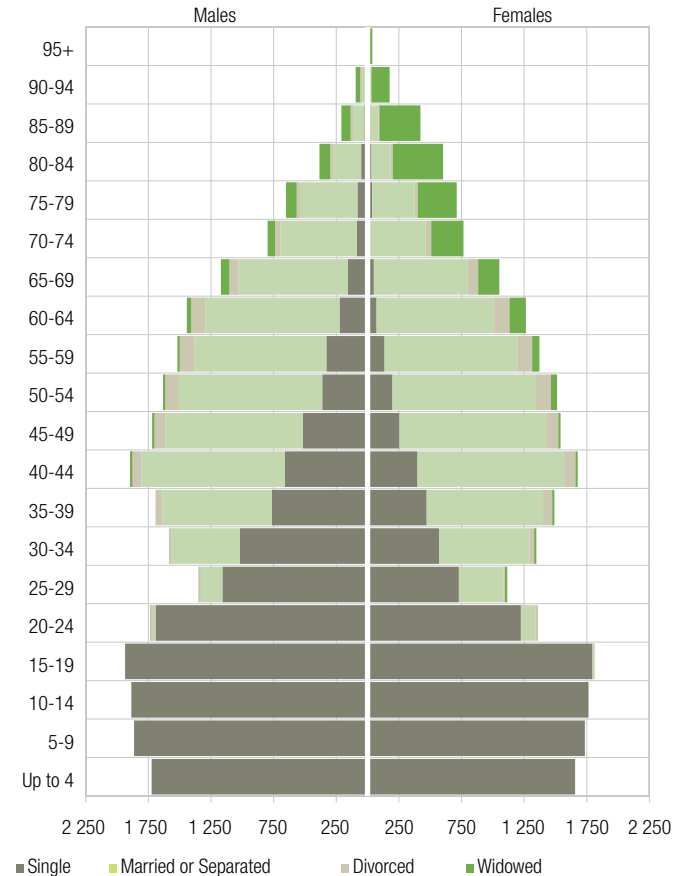

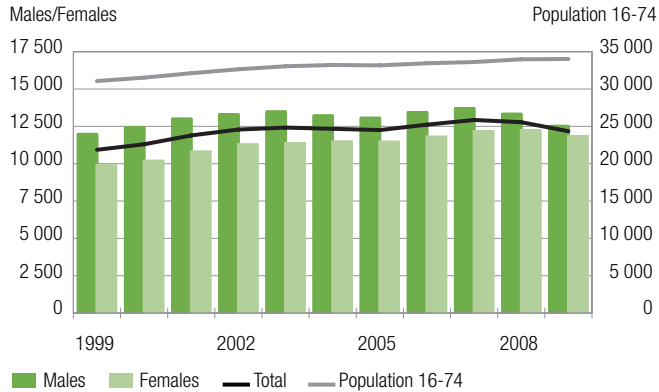

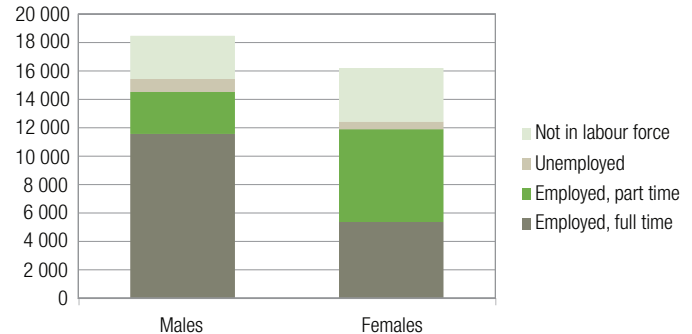

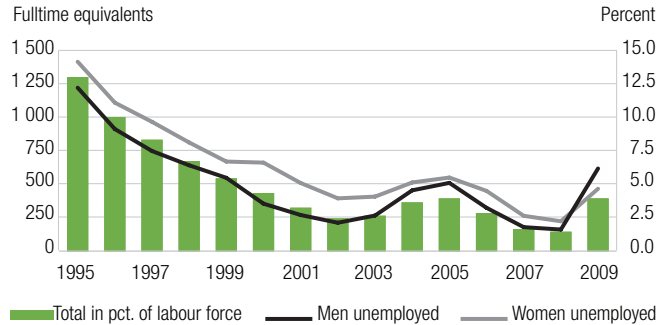

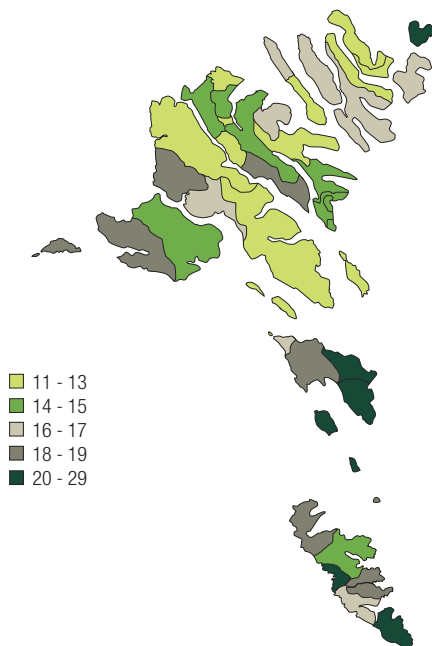

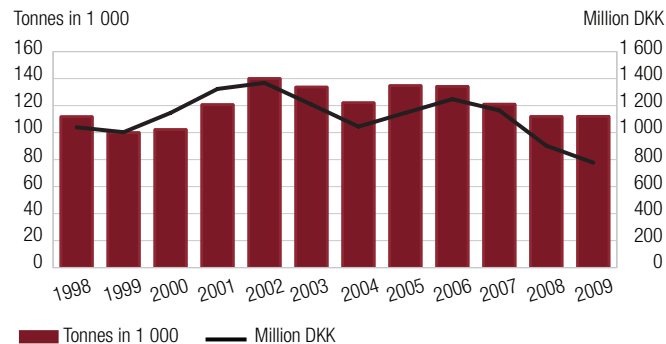

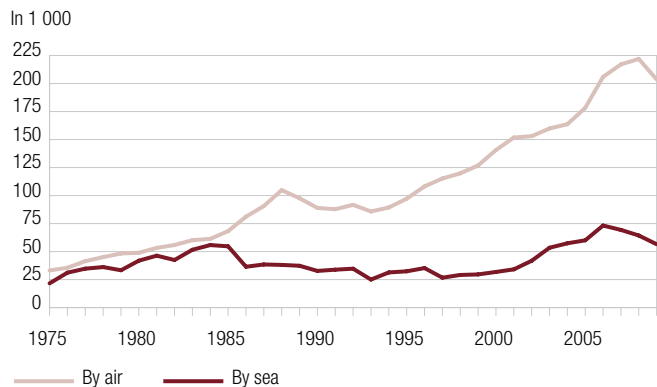

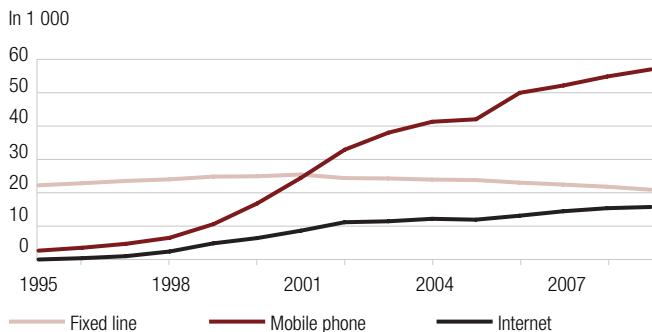

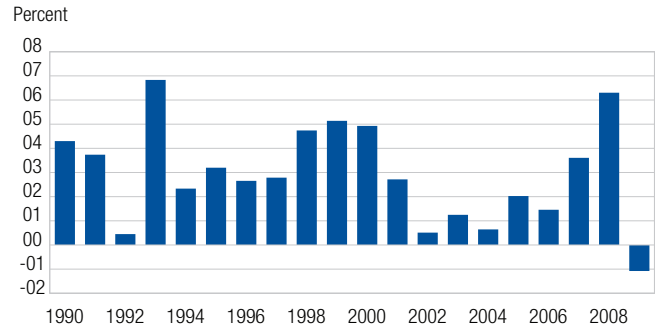

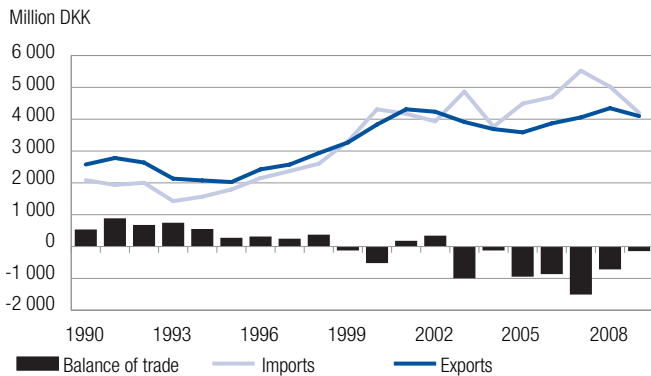

Balance of merchandise trade



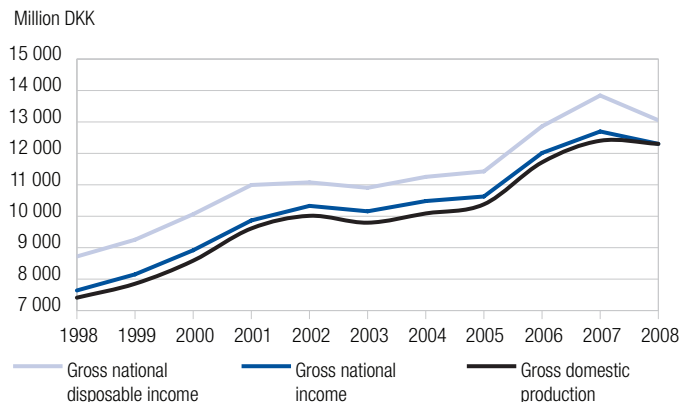
