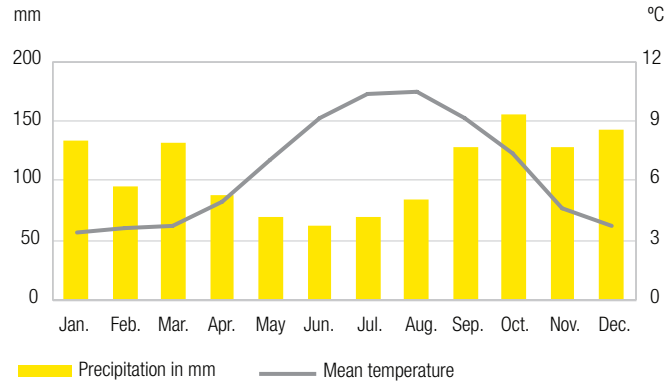

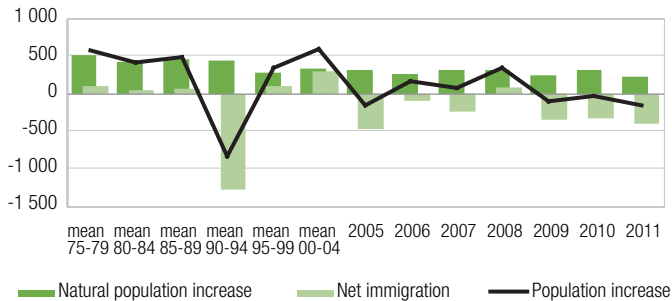

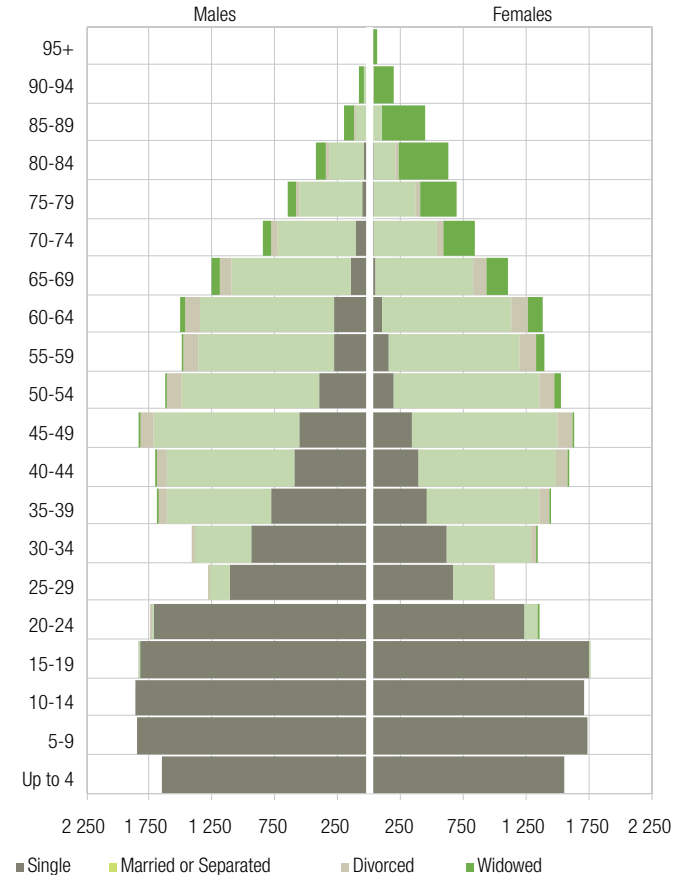

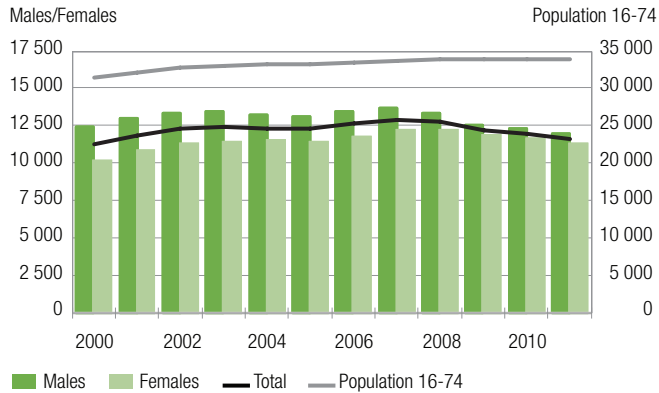

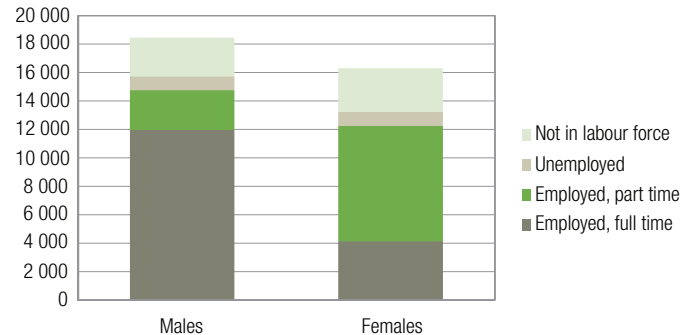

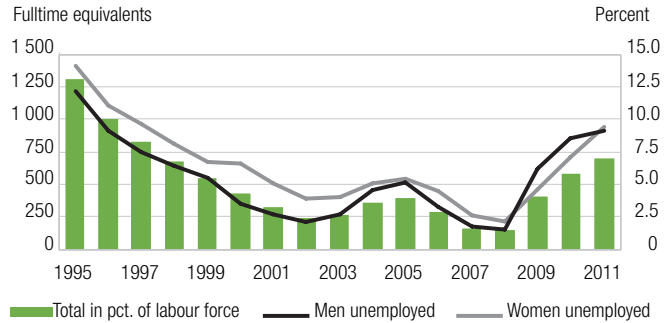

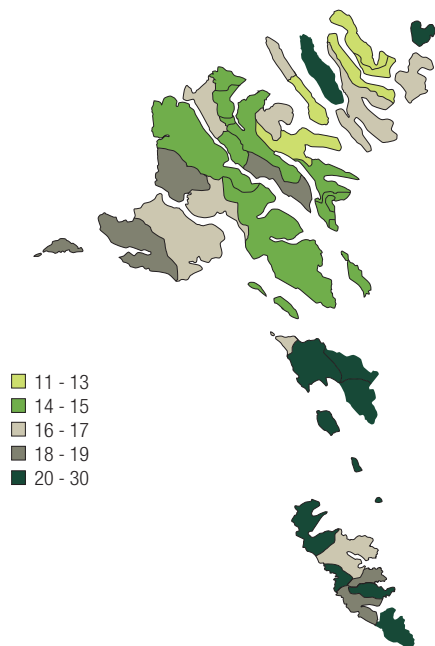

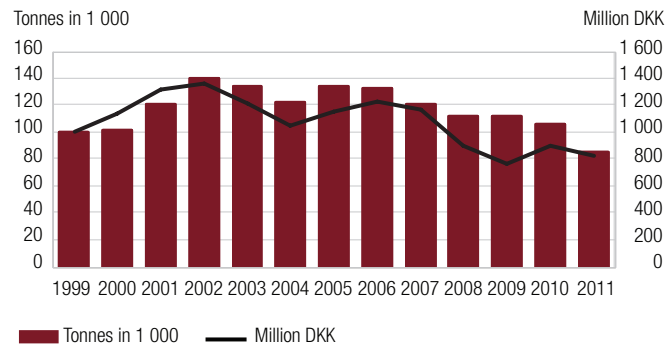

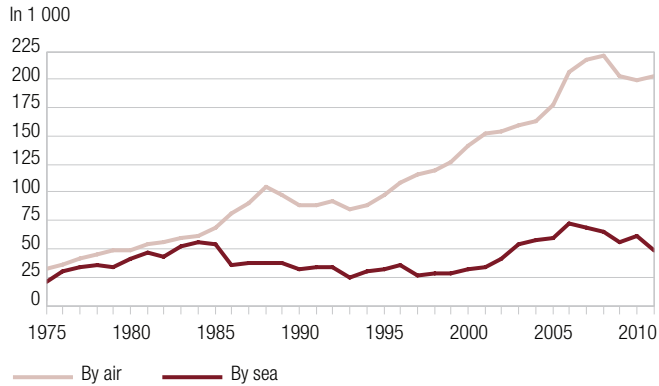

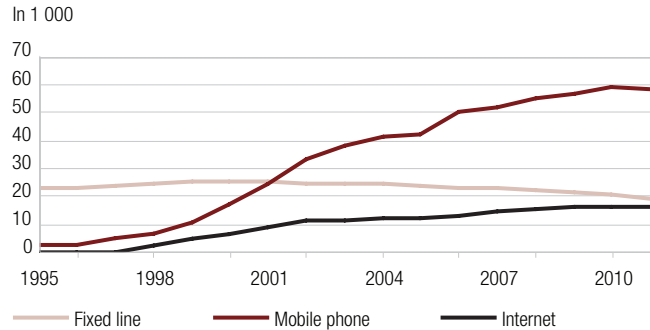

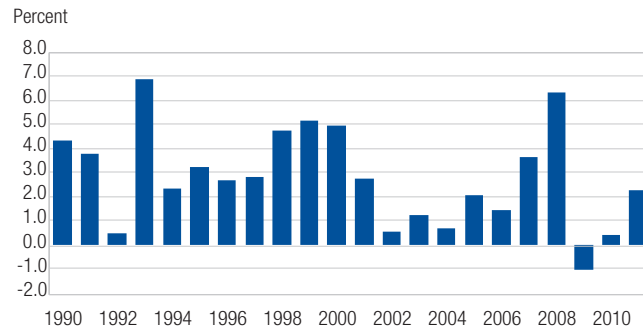

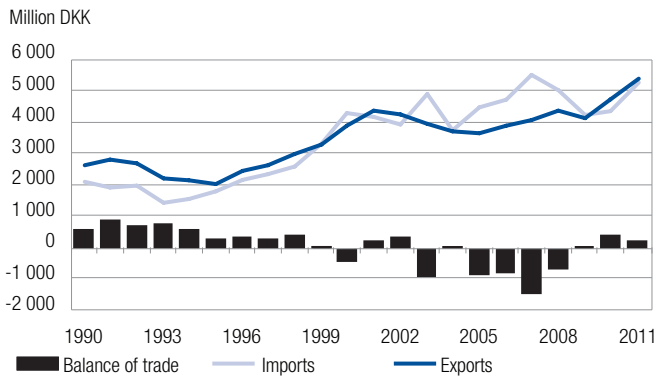

### Balance of merchandise trade



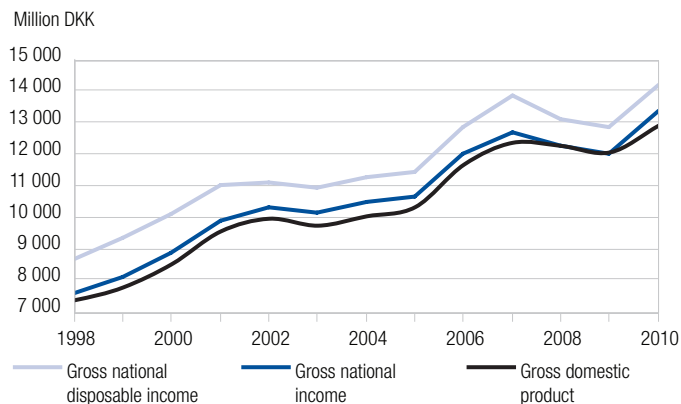
